# Hospitality Cleary University Star Scholarship

## **Description:**

The Livingston County Convention & Visitors Bureau Board (LCCVB) of Directors established annual "Hospitality Star Scholarships" for 2021. Two annual scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each will be awarded by the LCCVB. One to a current Cleary University Hospitality student and one to a high school senior in a Livingston County high school pursuing a degree in hospitality, outdoor recreation, marketing, or other related major. The applicant must meet the criteria and will be chosen by the LCCVB's Education Committee.

### Award:

A scholarship of \$1,500 will be awarded annually. The recipient will be honored at the LCCVB's Annual Partner Meeting on March 3, 2021.

## **Eligibility Factors**

- 1. Must be majoring in the tourism related field of study; hospitality, outdoor recreation, marketing, or other related major.
- 2. Must currently be enrolled at Cleary University
- 3. Cleary University transcript showing cumulative 3.0 GPA.
- 4. Must have a signed Major in Marketing & Hospitality, Outdoor Recreation, or related.

- Demonstrated quality in academic performance.
- 3. Two supportive references with original signatures. One required from each of the following categories: a) academic source; b) work/service source (preferably from a facility within the tourism industry).

- 1. Why have you chosen the tourism industry as your course of study?
- 2. What are your future goals / position in the tourism industry?
- 3. Why do you feel you should be awarded this scholarship?
- 4. What has been your most significant tourism experience to date and why?
